This is a dress up day and therefore the following rules apply:

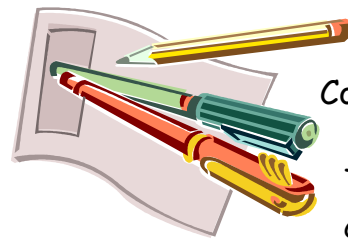
- ✓ No jeans
